



Programme requirements

- Know the basics of the programme, be aware of what we want
 - · Geography, support rate, budget limits etc.
 - If anything is unclear, refer to the written guidance or contact the JS
- Contribution to the programme indicators
- Cross-border added value
- Logical work plan
- Impact to the programme area (change in partnership rules)
- Do not apply just to get money, but to make a change!

Tips for planning the project

- Start early
- Involve the partners
- Consider target groups' needs
- Fill in the idea form
- Consult with the Joint Secretariat (JS)
- Consider the JS feedback when planning further

Tips for applying

- Jems is not meant to be a planning tool
- Keep the application texts short and concise
- Work plan/activities must be coherent with the budget
- Check that you have all, (but also only) the necessary attachments added
- Submit early, not during the last days
- Budget: understand SCOs
