

### SECOND CALL IN A NUTSHELL

The Programme received 53 project proposals for the Second call: 45 were regular project proposals, and 8 were small project proposals.

- 24 regular projects were selected to continue in the second step
- 5 small projects were approved
























**AVERAGE NUMBER OF PARTNERS** 














