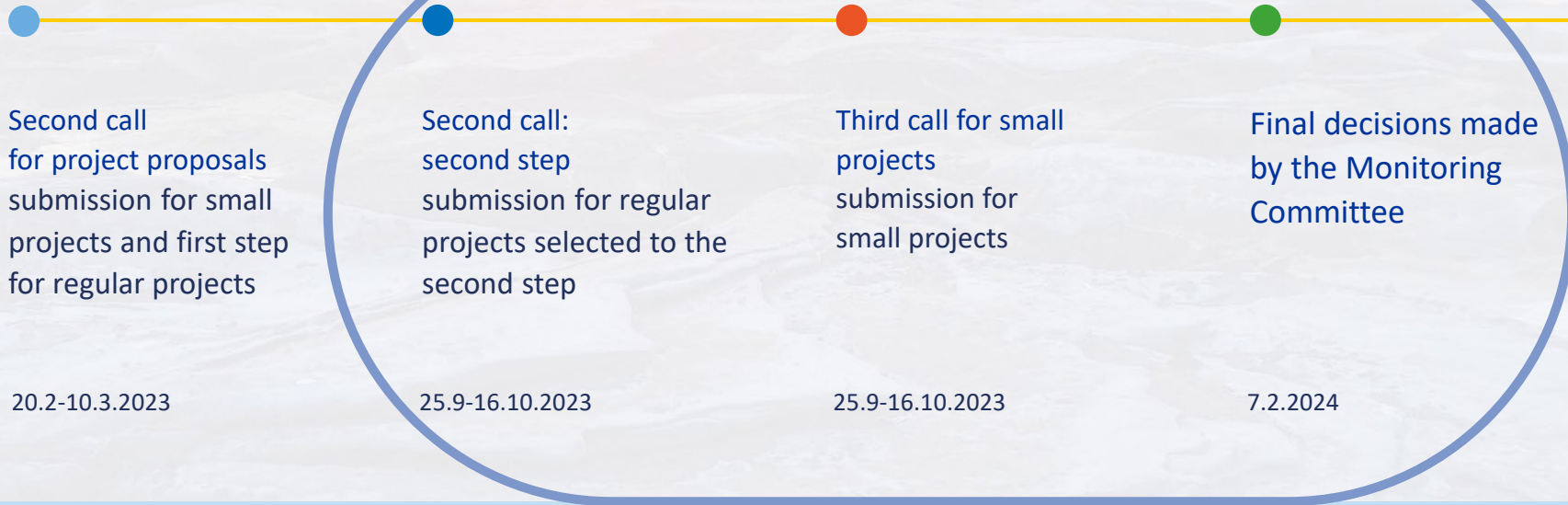

BACKGROUND

SECOND CALL IN A NUTSHELL

The Programme received 53 project proposals for the Second call: 45 were regular project proposals, and 8 were small project proposals.

- 24 regular projects were selected to continue in the second step
- 5 small projects were approved



BACKGROUND

THIRD CALL IN A NUTSHELL

- 23 small project proposals were submitted to the third call



In total, 23 small project proposals were submitted to the Third call.

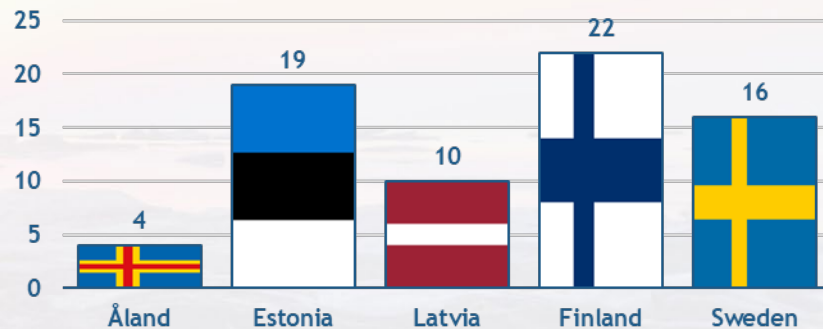

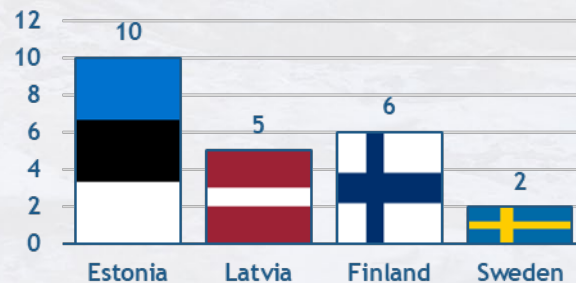

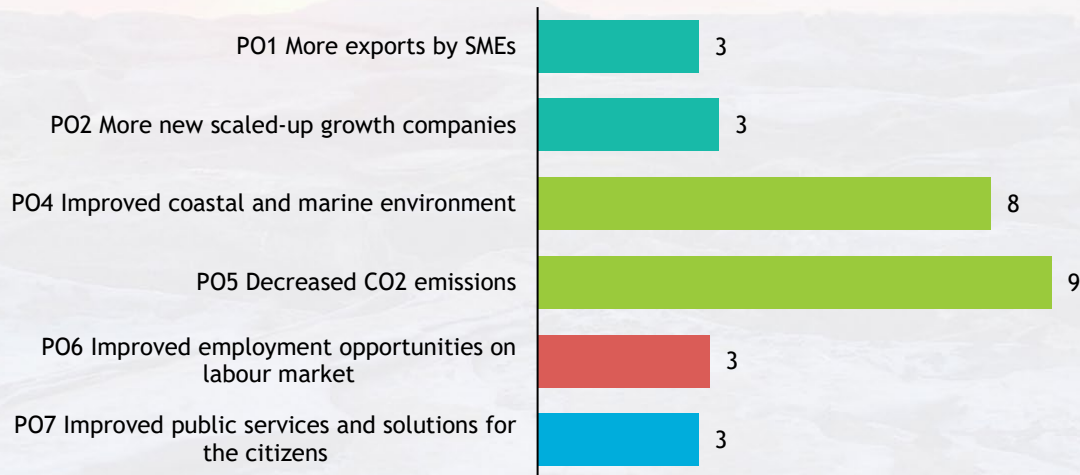

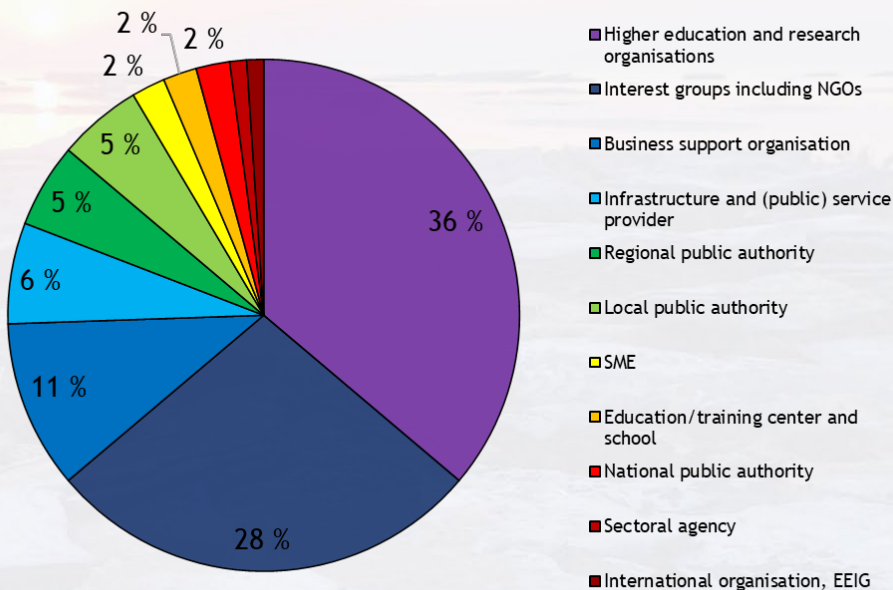


Average number of partners in projects approved

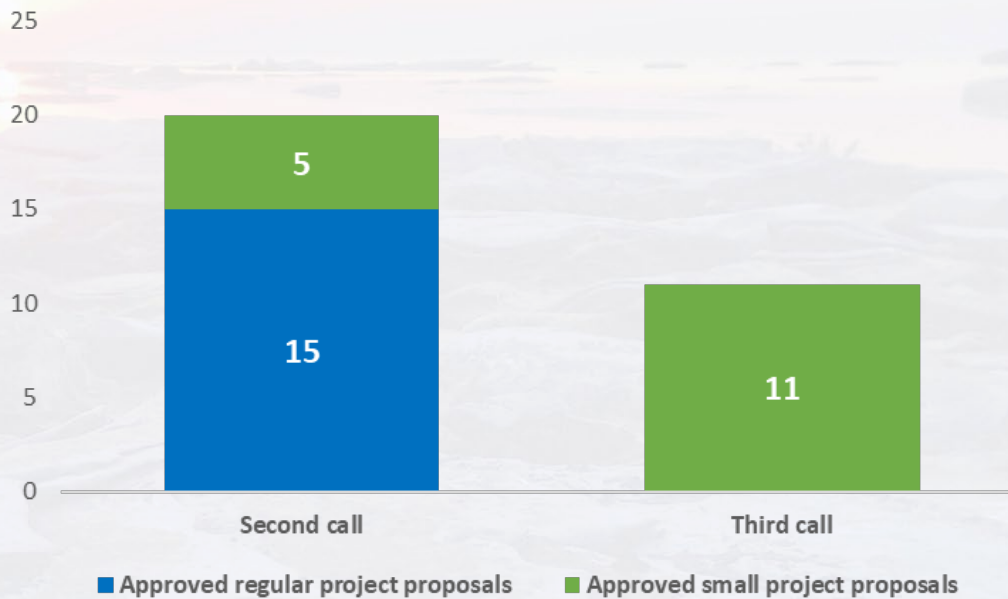

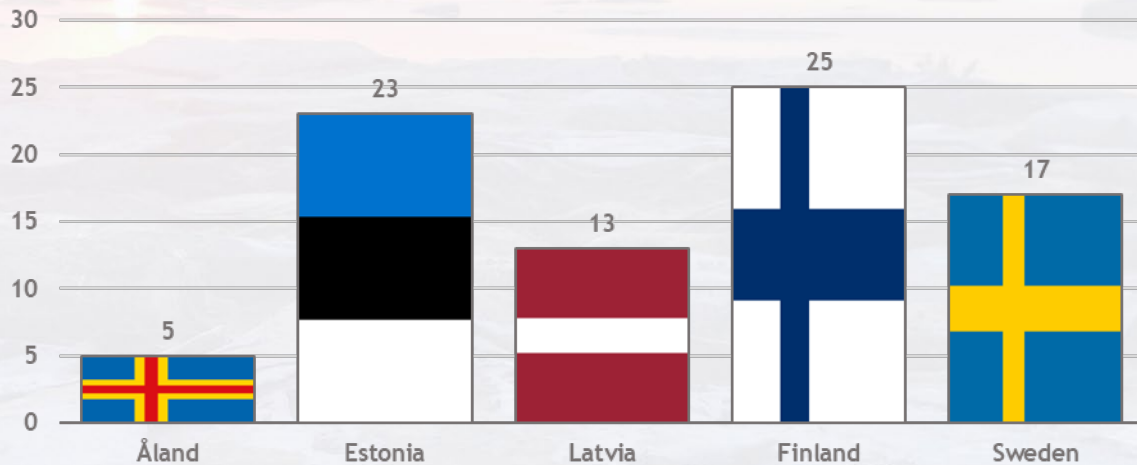

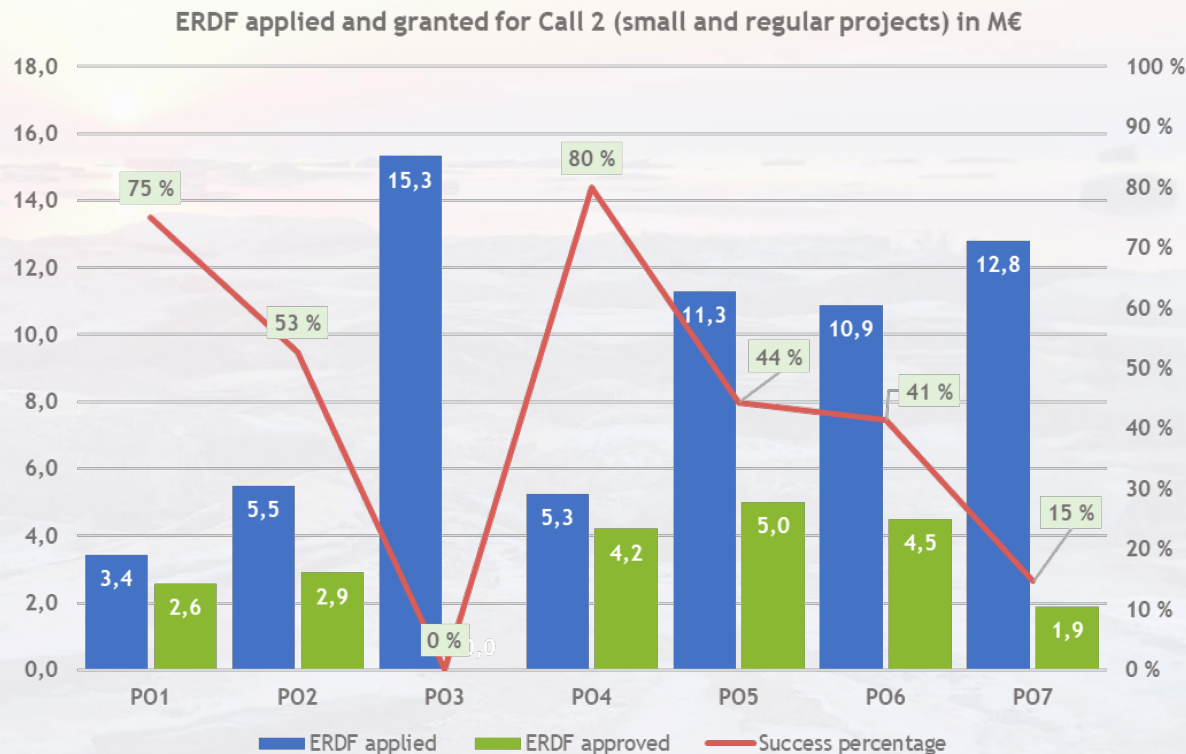

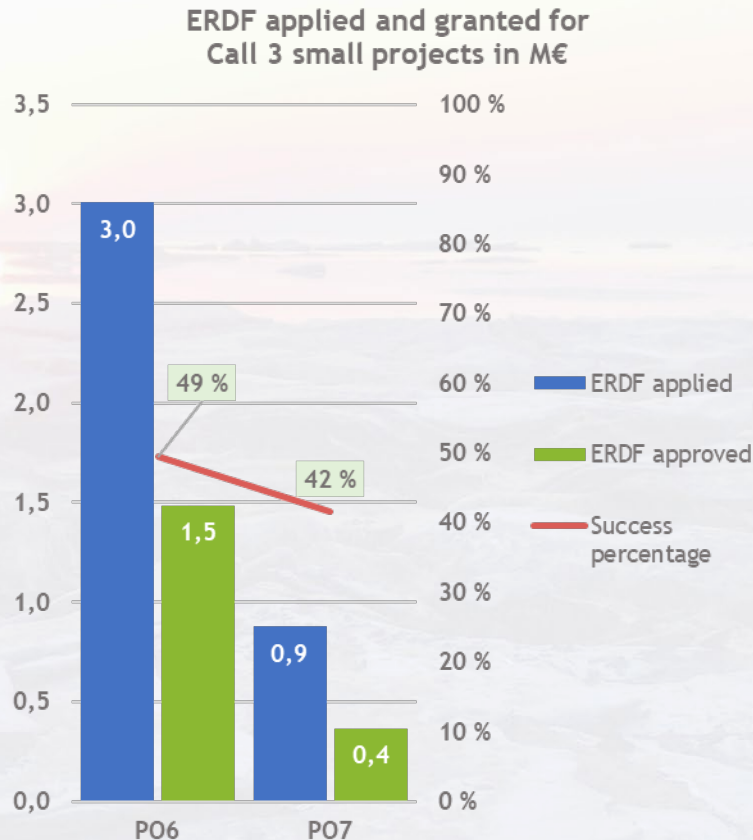
Origin of project partners for Call 2 (small and regular projects)



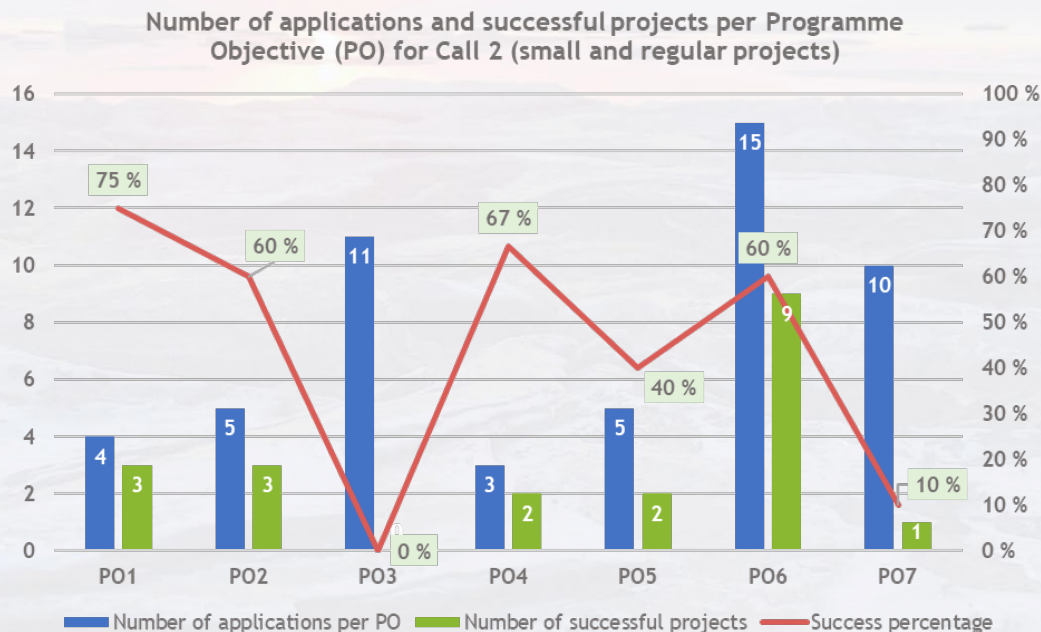
ERDF APPLIED AND GRANTED: SECOND CALL (SMALL AND REGULAR PROJECTS)



ERDF APPLIED AND GRANTED: THIRD CALL (SMALL PROJECTS)

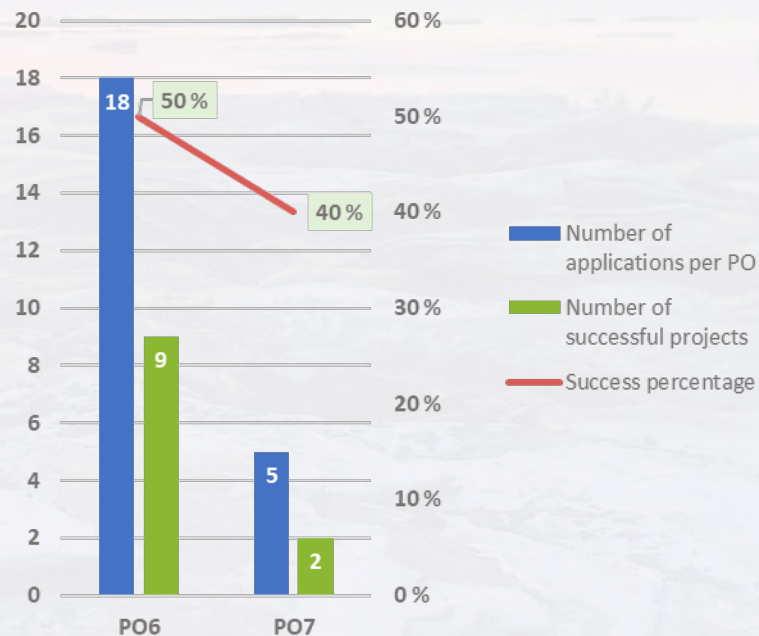


NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS AND SUCCESSFUL PROJECTS PER PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES FOR SECOND CALL
